MARC Library Information Term 2

Library, the Prep, 1 and 2's this term learnt about whales and read Matt Cosgrove books (Macca the Alpaca). We have drawn, cut and pasted, made maracas and a mini Macca with a beanie. We have listened to and enjoyed different poems and limericks. We have learnt about parts of a book – front/ back cover, spine, barcode, author, illustrator. The grade 1 and 2's, have used Orbit, the online library system to find new books, search for books by author, title, series and word.



In Library, the Grade 3,4,5 and 6's this term, have been reading books based on true stories. They have learnt about whales being beached at Busselton W.A. and the Busselton Jetty being the longest timber jetty in the Southern Hemisphere, Cathy Freeman and running against her Olympic time of 49.13 seconds for the 400 metres, the journey of a violin during the war, a child stowaway on a ship many years ago, native stingless bees, Louis Braille – how he invented the six dot Braille reading system, two women setting records 96 years ago driving a car across Australia, when women were usually at home, not driving cars and bar-tailed godwit birds making the longest unbroken journey of any animal in the world. We have used Orbit, the online library system to find new books, search for books by author, title, series, subject and word. We have listened to, performed and enjoyed different poems and limericks
